

Comprehensive Trainer Form Statistics: There are 36 trainer statistics that DRF is tracking, covering every trainer's record over this year and last year in a variety of situations. Up to 6 of these categories will show up under the bottom PP, depending on the number of applicable statistics. Each trainer stat will list: Category (12 0.17 \$1.83)

- . the number of Starts for the trainer in this category,
- . the Win Percentage for the trainer in this category
- and the \$2.00 Return On Investment

for the trainer in this category.

Every performance by every horse in North America is assigned a Beyer Speed Figure that reflects the time of the race and the inherent speed of the track over which it was run, permitting easy comparisons of efforts at different distances and tracks. In this system, 2 1/2 points are roughly equal to one length in sprints and 2 points to one length in routes.

Though the numerical comparison between Timeform Ratings and Beyer Speed Figures is not exactly connected, the most often used rule of thumb is Timeform Rating minus 13 = Bever Figure, which does seem to produce a strong correlation between the two

Daily Racing Form past performances contain a special set of ratings called Tomlinson Daily Hacing Form past performances contain a special set of ratings called Iomilinson Ratings. These ratings appear in the career box above each horse's past performance. These three separate ratings (from 0 to 480) are based on a horse's breeding, and its likely aptitude for wet tracks, the turf, and compatibility with today's scheduled race distance. Distance ratings reflect all performances, regardless of whether races are run on dirt, turf or synthetic surfaces.

A wet rating of 320+ is a horse that merits further consideration on a muddy or sloppy track. The distance ratings, with a rating of 320 considered average, might prove especially useful when handicapping horses who may be better suited for sprints, middle

Tomlinson Ratings are especially useful in maiden races, 2-year-old races, races switched to a main track listed as "sloppy" or "muddy," horses trying mud, slop, or turf for the first or second time, or horses stretching out in distance.
